Project Title: Hurricane Katrina Disaster Relief Effort

Location: New Orleans, LA

Scope: Development and operations of a temporary debris disposal facility at the Peters Road Dump Site in Jefferson Parish, LA

Berner Construction provided equipment, material and labor to assist in the disaster relief effort for Hurricane Katrina. Berner Construction mobilized excavators, water trucks, bull dozers, wheel loaders, and temporary living facilities to support the operation of a temporary disposal facility to handle municipal trash and other debris.



Peters Road Dump Site Operations

Berner Construction was responsible for development and operations of the eight acre, temporary, debris disposal facility located in Jefferson Parish, LA. The Peters Road Dump Site received trash, demolition debris, white goods, trees, stumps, etc. from various locations throughout the City of New Orleans.

Facility management included traffic control, dust suppression, stormwater management, and access road maintenance. Site operations included management of incoming materials, debris consolidation and reduction, loading of debris into 115 cubic yard transfer trucks, site regrading and restoration. The temporary disposal facility managed more than 200,000 cubic yards of debris during the three months of operation.

Berner Construction also provided equipment and personnel to removal and dispose of debris from the streets and roads throughout the Parish and City of New Orleans.
