



## **BERNER CONSTRUCTION, INCORPORATED PROJECT SUMMARY**

**Project Title:** Professional Consulting Services, City of Philadelphia Office of Fleet Management

**Location:** Various locations in the City of Philadelphia and the Philadelphia International Airport

**Scope:** Provide underground storage tank (UST) expertise and professional consulting services to the City of Philadelphia Office of Fleet Management (OFM)

Berner Construction working in conjunction with Oxford Engineering has been contracted to provide underground storage tank (UST) expertise and environmental engineering consulting services to the Office of Fleet Management for the City of Philadelphia. OFM is responsible for



all underground fuel oil tanks located throughout the City and at Philadelphia International Airport. There are over 170 sites and 300 tanks currently managed by OFM. These tanks were brought into compliance with the state and federal programs through an aggressive program in the late 1980s and early 1990s to meet the 1998 mandated compliance date. However, some of the older sites still have remediation issues that need to be addressed. Berner Construction is assisting OFM in evaluating and developing solutions for these sites.

### **Old UST Removal**

Recent operations inspections have identified corrosion protection issues with numerous sites and Berner Construction developed a prioritized system for bringing these sites into full compliance with the UST regulations. Berner Construction assisted in negotiations with PADEP to memorialize a Memorandum of Agreement to accomplish this work. Berner Construction also provides environmental engineering consultation on any UST remedial work in accordance with PADEP Act 32 and Act 2 regulations. Berner Construction has also assisted OFM in obtaining funding under the USTIF regulations to defray the costs of past and present remedial work.
